

# Maude Kerns Supply List

Instructor: Karleena Graham Class: Beginning Oil Painting

This is a beginning class so student-grade supplies will work just fine.

#### **Paint**

- 1- Alizarin Crimson
- 1- Hansa Yellow
- 1- Ultramarine Blue
- 1 -Burnt Umber
- 1- Titanium White
- Approximately 1.25 fl oz or more
- No need to purchase large tubes at this time
- Student-grade like Daler-Rowney Georgian

## **Palette**

- 1- ceramic dish (approximately 12" square or diameter; or larger)
- You can find these items at Bring Recycle or a thrift store
- Dishes not to be used for eating

-OR-

1- 12 x 12" or larger glass panel (edges duct taped for safety)

#### **Palette Knives**

- 1- Diamond shape head
- Can be plastic or metal w/wooden handle
- #12-14 size (sizes are usually on metal/wood supplies)

## **Brushes** (oil; long-handled)

- 1- Flat #8
- 1- Round #8
- 1- Round #2 or #3 (for detail)

### **Canvas or Canvas Board**

4 - 11 x 14 (to start)

16 x 20 (Wait to purchase this size until you are certain you wish to work this large. Around week 4 or 5, we can discuss the 16 x 20 painting surface)

## **Rags or Paper Towels**

Supply Case or Tote for storage of supplies and materials Container for soiled rags/ paper towels
