This is a beginning class so student-grade supplies will work just fine.

Paint

I like using Winsor Newton for Watercolors and their Cotman line are their beginner tubes. So they're not too expensive. I also use the Cotman pocket sketchers watercolor set of 12. It has a large range of the colors we use for earth tones and it's in a small box set you can take on the go.

Colors you should purchase for our class

- Lemon yellow
- Cadmium yellow
- Yellow ochre
- Viridian hue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cadmium red.

Pencils

Fine Line Sharpie

Artist masking tape

Brushes

A variety of watercolor brushes in small medium and large sizes. A general variety pack of 6 rounded and flat edge brushes will work great. Artist Loft has great starter packs.

Watercolor paper

9x12 watercolor pack by Strathmore is a great starting point. Cold press is great for beginners and has more texture.

Paint Palette

You can use one while in the studio. The benefit to having your own is when you have a good color that you have mixed, you can add water again to it and reuse it.
