At this year's **Art and the Vineyard Festival, July 3, 4, & 5**, we anticipate an increased art-buying audience due to a new musical collaboration with the nationally recognized **Oregon Bach Festival** and expanded advertising by our **Title Sponsor, Comcast**. On July 4th the Oregon Bach Festival will perform Gershwin's *Rhapsody in Blue*, leading into a crescendo of **Freedom Festival Fireworks** under the stars in Eugene's Alton Baker Park.

The festival draws over 30,000 attendees and includes Art For Your Garden, Wine Court, an International Food Court, Youth Art Arena, Youth Stage, and the Main Stage featuring national and regional musicians.

ART FOR YOUR GARDEN

The Art For Your Garden area includes artworks within a unique landscape design to emphasize the beauty in nature and to provide ideas on how to incorporate art objects in a garden setting.

Handcrafted arbors and trellises, stone and metal sculpture, water fountains, and birdbaths are placed in appropriate, aesthetic settings to suggest to buyers that art does belong in gardens, on porches, by pathways, etc. **Hours of operation for ONLY Art for Your Garden are:**

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

Garden furniture, pottery, planters, urns, tiles, masks, birdbaths, bird feeders and houses, wind chimes, lanterns, sculptures, kiosks, sundials, window boxes, gates, and abstract pieces. Suggestions of additional imaginative work are welcome. There is no limit to the number of pieces that accepted artists can exhibit for sale.

Artists interested in applying are requested to supply (4) images on CD in **jpeg format** which are most representative of artwork to be displayed at the festival. The CD should be marked clearly and legibly with the artist's name and company name (if applicable). Individual image files on CD should be labeled with artist's name and title of works.

Maude Kerns Art Center reserves the right to use selected images for publicity and promotion purposes, with credit given to the artist.

SELECTION PROCESS

Art and the Vineyard is open to all artists and craftspeople producing original art. Commercially produced work, art assembled from kits, or imported art and goods cannot be accepted. The festival seeks the finest quality artwork through the jury process.

A panel of experienced art professionals will jury selections based solely on the quality and creativity of work represented in the images submitted by each artist-applicant. All interested artists, including past participants, are required to submit an application and CD of images.



FEES

While there is no entry fee for Art For Your Garden, there will be a **30% commission** on all art sales. Maude Kerns Art Center will handle all sales at the event and will issue artists a check within thirty days of the close of the event. Your commission supports the year-round programming of Maude Kerns Art Center.

INSURANCE

Artists are responsible for the security of their work at all times. Participating artists must provide proof of property and liability insurance or sign an appropriate release holding harmless the Maude Kerns Art Center and the event manager in the event of loss, damage, or theft during the festival. Security is provided.
