Pencil (Any 2B Pencil will do)

Eraser

Watercolor Sketchbook or Block (Cold Press 140lb at least 8x10)

Watercolor Brushes (Make sure they are for watercolor, no hard bristle brushes)

- Shorthandle Round 12
- Flat 1"

Watercolor Water Reservoir

- Look for any old mason jar or empty butter tub. Recycle when you can!
- The bigger the better!

Watercolor Palette

- Any white plastic or porcelain palette will do. Just make sure there is room for mixing colors.

Watercolor Paints

- We will be working with a limited palette of 5 colors.
- They can be tubes or pans.
