The supply list for this class is vague because I want you to use whatever supplies you're most comfortable with! If you're a plein air watercolor fan with a panorama-style watercolor sketchbook for example, use that! If you'd rather work in pen and ink in a square sketchbook, great! The main criteria is: that everything will need to be highly portable and as pared down as possible since we're going to be working in various locations. We'll be talking a lot about how to capture the space you're in through different methods. If you're unsure what you'd like to do, we'll go over everything during the first class and you can prep from there.

ART NECESSITIES

- Sketchbook in your preferred size (no smaller than 6" in at least one dimension)
- Drawing materials, such as
 - o Pencils for sketching
 - o Eraser
 - o Inking pens/colored pencils/markers/paint pens (if you like those)
- Plein Air supplies (if you plan on working in paint)
 - o Travel watercolor set. I like Koi for premade sets with everything you need. If you're making your own, make sure to bring the palette with paints already in each well, not a bag full of tubes of paint you need to squeeze out individually
 - If you'd like to work in acrylic, preload a "Stay Wet" palette
 - You can adapt gouache to work here, but it'll take some extra effort and be a bit messy
 - I do not recommend working in oil for this class
 - Ask me if you would like to work in another medium not mentioned!
 - o Water brush
 - o Rag/tiny sponge for cleaning brush
 - o Small sealed cup filled with water

EXCURSION NECESSITIES: STARTING WEEK 3
